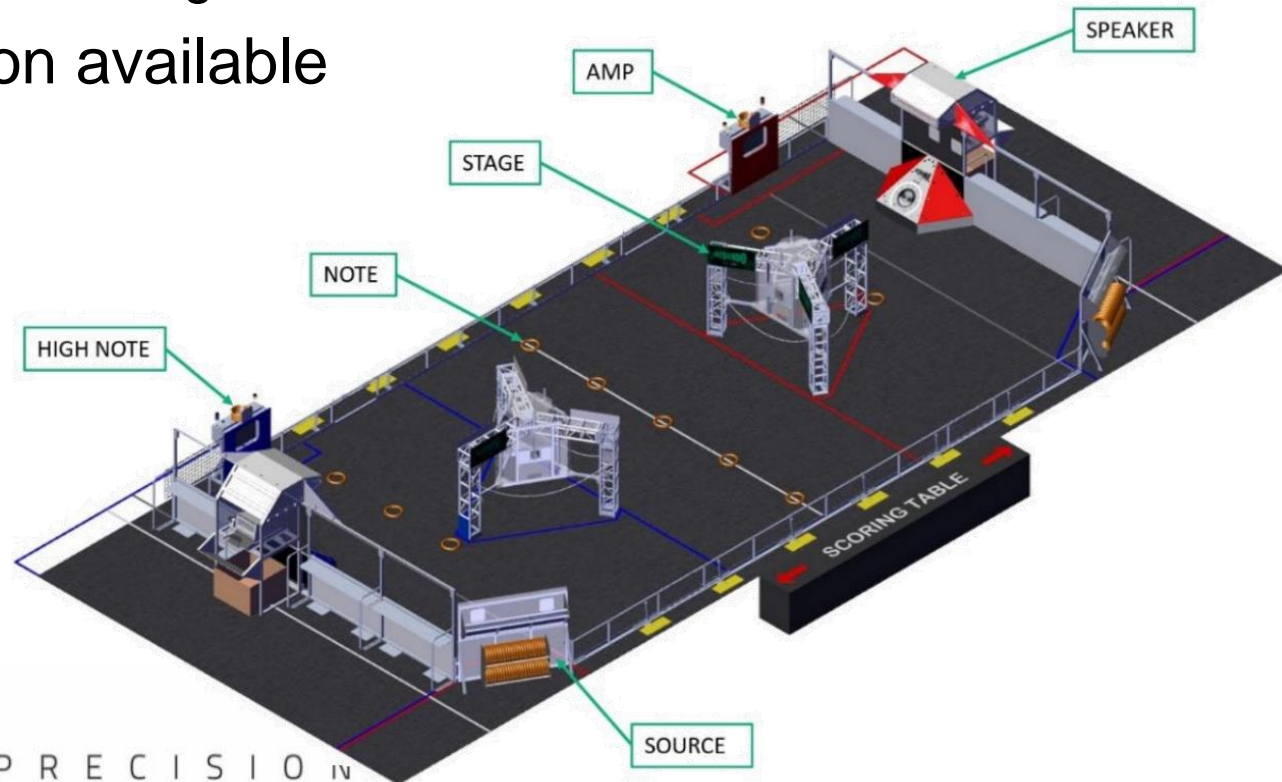
# Game Summary

# Field Trip Rules

- BHS Code of Conduct and Team 3176 Student Handbook always apply
- Students need to represent Team 3176 professionally
- These can be very **LONG** days
  - Competitions are a privilege and not a requirement
  - Students need to stay engaged with team competition and all students will have roles to support (drive team, pit team, scouting team, awards team, etc.)
- If students have any issues, find one of the co-sponsors or other adult mentor
- Students violating rules will sent home at parents' responsibility



# Travel Logistics

## Getting to / from District Event Competitions

- BCSC school bus leaving early morning of Day 1
  - A few students will go day earlier afternoon (drive / pit)
- Returning late Day 2 evening

## Hotel

- Holiday Inn Express – Elkhart South & Washington
- 4 students / room – Rooms will be assigned
- Not a lot of time will be spent at the hotel

## Travel Surveys for each trip

# State Championship Event

- **April 6 & 7 (Jefferson HS, Lafayette, IN)**
- **Team would need to qualify for State Championship**
- **Top 32 robots in the state (out of ~60)**
- **NOT an overnight trip – Two day-trips (up & back)**
- **Does not require missing Friday school day as in the past**
  - **Load-in pit team will be excused Friday afternoon**



# Travel Requirements

- To attend the competition events, students need to complete:
  - **Handbook forms** (*incl Field Trip form*)
  - **Registered on-line with *FIRST***
  - **Student Fees**
  - **BCSC Medical Consent** (*next slide*)
  - **Financial Sponsor visit**
  - **Academic eligibility**
  - **General team contributions / attitude**
- Reminders have been e-mailed to students & parents



# BCSC Medical Consent Form

- **ALL** students need to complete form
  - <http://www.brownsburg.k12.in.us/extended-trip>
- Form needs to be filled out and turned in **2 weeks** before the trip
- Daily medicines need to be provided to BHS school nurse for verification a minimum of **7 days prior to trip**
- Only the amount of medication needed for the trip
- Medications will be given on the trip by a trained BCSC employee
- Video (~2 mins)
